Timetable Timetable: Ranging between 2-3 days per week, you will be required to undertake on campus learning on Tuesdays [12:00pm - 8:00pm] and Thursdays [8:00am - 5:00pm]. Depending on your semester of study, further online learning will be scheduled on Wednesdays (9:00am - 12:00pm and/or 2:00 – 5:00). Online learning may include flexible delivery including live online sessions, recorded lectures and self-directed learning. First Aid is delivered over 2 days in Stage 1a and may be scheduled across any days of the week. Work placements are normally 40 hours per week in blocks, apart from Primary Health Care, which can be allocated as individual days or in blocks.
